A trip to the South Shore isn't complete without a lobster supper at the famed Shore Club in Hubbards, famous for great live music and serving more than a million lobster suppers over the past 70 years. 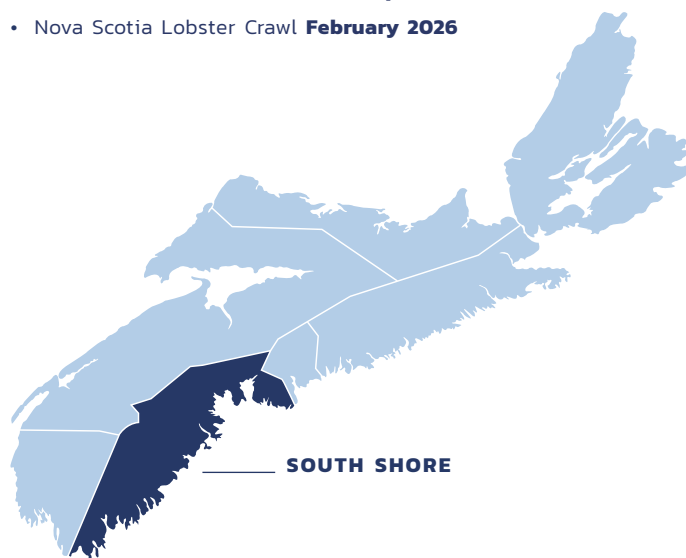
